Title: Religious Education Teacher

THE JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Boone Unitarian Universalist Fellowship, a local liberal religious community, is seeking an enthusiastic teacher to work with our children ages 6-11 on Sunday mornings as part of our Religious Education program. Our ideal candidate is excellent with kids, has knowledge and experience with curriculum and instruction, and is in harmony with the beliefs and practices of Unitarian Universalism, which can be found here: https://www.uua.org/beliefs.

Duties include planning spiritually-themed activities for our children (derived from existing curricula and materials from the Unitarian Universalist Association) and collaborating with one of our childcare workers to create an environment of creativity, cooperation, learning, and fun.

The position is approximately 3 hours per week for 9 months a year from September 1 through May 30. A typical Sunday class will run for one hour (from approximately 11:15 a.m.-12: 15 p.m.). Other work hours include planning and preparation time, special events, and occasional meetings with parents, the RE Coordinator, and the Boone UU Presidents' Council. Pay is \$50 a week, paid bi-weekly. Unpaid time off for holidays, personal leave, or other needs is negotiable. Diverse applicants encouraged to apply.
